The two-point conversion, which existed in the AFL when the Bengals were members in 1968 and '69, was not instituted in the NFL until '94.

\*\*\*NOTE: It is not possible to accurately list all-time postseason defensive statistics because the three types of defensive statistics — defense, special teams and miscellaneous — were combined through 1987, but separated in '88 and thereafter.
